Seat allotment for North East States students comes under the category of SUPERNUMERARY ADMISSION; therefore, the eligibility criteria given in CSAB NEUT -2016 Information brochure is recommended for the admission in B.Tech. First year programme of this University. The eligibility criteria given in information brochure is

- (i) secured a rank in JEE (Main) Paper-1 (B.E./B.Tech.), and
- (ii) Passed class XII (or equivalent) examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry/Biotechnology/Biology/Technical Vocational subjects. Obtained at least 45% marks for GEN (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in each of subjects.

In view of the above criteria for admission, the committee recommend the admission of all candidates except at S.N. 2 & 4.
