**NOTICE FOR B.Tech. FINAL YEAR STUDENTS (SESSION 2018-19)**

Proposals are invited for annual scholarship "RSRM Tripathi best project award" (a sum of Rs.40,000/=) from the students of B.Tech. Final Year (VII semester) Computer Science and Engineering department. The students in the project should not have any back paper till 6<sup>th</sup> semester of the B.Tech. program.

All the interested teams consisting of at most 4 students will send the project proposal to the donor. The proposal should include minimum of 4-page description of the project with:

- Describe how it relates to the modern trends in the industry
- Describe how the project is novel and unique
- Why was the project chosen, how does it relate to the learnings
- What strength each member provides to the project
- Clarity and intent of the project
- High level design and Flow Charts

Based on the submitted projects, the donor will select 4 projects to compete for the award. The Final award will be based on the demonstration of the project and will be judged among the best 4 shortlisted projects in the initial round by the constituted committee as per the MoU.

**Time Lines:**

1. Send Proposals for the project to the donor "smtripathi@gmail.com" with appropriate Title with reference to the RSRM Tripathi award till end of November-2018.
2. In the month of December-2018 the 4 project teams will be shortlisted for the final round by the donor.
3. At the end of the 8th and final semester, the best implemented project to be evaluated by the committee.
4. Award may be done during the Graduation ceremony.

The proposals can be from among the projects to be carried out during the final year curriculum under supervision of the faculty members during session 2018-19.
