

Kindly note failure to include SDG alignment in your research outputs (papers, patents, or funded that projects) will lead to disqualification from eligibility for any university provided research incentives, including awards, grants, and financial benefits related to research excellence.

All the concerned are requested to comply with this directive with immediate effect. Let us work together to ensure that our research support not only academic advancement but also sustainable and equitable global development. All HODs are requested to circulate among their faculty & Research Scholars of their department.
